Provided an overview of technology and security in the new school. There will be advanced security interlocking access control doors; monitored by Security for better control of who enters the building. Radio frequency names tags for every exterior door. About 100 digital security cameras with advanced artificial intelligence “motion detection” features. There will also be digital signage in the cafeteria and the entrance. There will be projectors in every classroom with interactive displays (functionality of a smartboard). Wireless connection for teachers.

Moton will move into the new building over Spring Break. There will be no school on April 7th and 8th for Moton students ONLY. On the last day of school before Spring Break (Friday, April 3rd), students will bring home everything from their lockers and desks.
